

CASA of El Paso has a full-time Child Advocacy Specialist position available. The Child Advocacy Specialist (CAS) will motivate, empower, guide, and supervise CASA volunteers as they advocate in the best interest of children to whom CASA is appointed by the courts, while ensuring accountability for meeting CASA of El Paso's values, policies, and standards of case management are met. Additionally, the Child Advocacy Specialist will fulfill the performance standards of Texas and National CASA, ensuring that advocates comply with the statutory obligations of guardian *ad litem* and meeting or exceeding the expectations of the El Paso County courts. The CAS must demonstrate cultural humility in their interaction with children and families.

A minimum of a Bachelor's degree is required. Preferred candidates will have experience in providing staff or volunteer supervision and ability to manage people and a demonstrated commitment to diversity of thought and experience effectively working with a diverse population and understanding the impact of race and equity in larger systems. **Spanish/English fluency is considered an advantage.**
